Turn right at the light and go about 3 miles to Whitesburg Rd., turn left and go abouit 1 mile, make a left and the Dairy is a short distance up the road. The BEST homemade ice cream ever, along with lots of homestyle jams, jellies, relishes, pickled vegetables, bread mixes, local corn fed beef steaks, ground beef,

local sausage and bacon, fresh butter and cheese. It is THE BEST and worth the ride.

New Bakery in town: Check out the new bakery on Maddox Blvd. Lots of special desserts and breads.
